3. <u>Planning</u>

PA15/11721 – Application by Mr and Mrs C Dean for first floor extension, terrace and alterations at Timberdown, Water Lane, Golant

Councillor S Reardon said that, in her opinion, the proposal will improve the dwelling and will not be visible from many other dwellings. Councillor R Anderson said that the site comprises a large plot and the proposed extension, terrace and alterations will be a substantial improvement. It was proposed by Councillor R Anderson and seconded by Councillor S Ratchford that the application be supported. All Councillors voted in favour of this proposal.
