

Report by THE GOLANT PILL for the Parish Council AGM on 28 th
May, 2019

Our village bi-monthly newsletter, The Golant Pill, is now in its 13 th
year of production.

Currently, the total number distributed by Jacky Fletcher is 162,
including a village total of 129, with 25
posted and 8 collected in church by supportive church-going non-
villagers.

These days, the printing is outsourced to Palace Printers in
Lostwithiel, who not only produce excellent
quality copy, but also make a very reasonable charge. In the past,
when the Pill was printed 'at home', we
had to pay for the many disposable printer parts which frequently
needed replacing, and our overall
printing costs were much higher.

We would like to thank the loyal advertisers, some remaining with us
from Issue 1, who continue to
support our newsletter, as well as those individuals who make
private donations. Without this revenue,
we would find it difficult to keep afloat. Other income which boosts
our funds is produced by the
continued sale of our published Recipe & Gardening books. This
year, we are pleased to have been able
to contribute towards the cost of the refurbished steps at St
Sampson's Church.
