## NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

### for the St Sampson Neighbourhood Plan

1. A Referendum will be held on **Thursday, 16th September 2021** to decide the question:

**“Do you want Cornwall Council to use the neighbourhood plan for St Sampson to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”**

2. Applications to register to vote or to vote by post or proxy should be made to the Electoral Registration Officer at 3rd Floor, South Wing, County Hall, Treyew Road, Truro, TR1 3AY based on the deadlines set out below:

New applications to vote by post or to cancel or amend an existing postal/proxy vote	5 pm on Wednesday, 1st September 2021
New applications to vote by proxy	5 pm on Wednesday, 8th September 2021
Applications for an emergency proxy vote (in cases where unforeseen illness, incapacity, occupation, service or employment occurs after the deadline for proxy applications).  The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 8th September 2021.  To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 8th September 2021.	5 pm on Thursday, 16th September 2021
